It has been recently pointed out to the authors by Dr. E.H. Jacobs, that the review “*The Circadian Clock in Mammals*” written by Zordan and Kyriacou (2000) contains an extensive stretch of text which was the exact copy of material from a previously published article which appeared in *Trends in Pharmacological Sciences* (Vol 21, pp 293–298, 2000) by Jacobs EH, Yamatodani A and Timmerman H, entitled “*Is histamine the final neurotransmitter in the entrainment of circadian rhythms in mammals?*”.

I have since examined the matter in detail and, following an analysis of my archived computer files relating to the drafts, it appeared that I had prepared various files, many of which contained excerpts of original text to be used as reference material during the elaboration of the final text. In

typing the manuscript, I inadvertently included one of these “working” files, containing a copy of a section of text from the article by E.H. Jacobs et al., rather than the intended one that I had written by myself. I accept full responsibility for this unfortunate incident and I wish to underline that the incident was completely unintentional. I express my deepest apologies to the authors of the original article, and to the editors of both journals involved.
